QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE - RULES AND REGULATIONS

IF IN DOUBT – PLEASE ASK

- If you have any questions about what is or isn't permissible at the Burial Park please inquire at the office. Taking a moment to inquire first will help to avoid the upset that can occur when we remove and dispose of unauthorized items placed at a grave or memorial site.

VISITING HOURS

- The Burial Park is open every day of the year for visiting. Gates open at 8:30 a.m.
- Gates are closed and locked at dusk every night. Closing time will vary depending on the season but it is clearly marked on the entry gate and map kiosk inside the gate.

OFFICE HOURS

- Monday to Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. The office is closed on Saturday, Sunday and holidays.

FLOWERS

- **March through October:** Only fresh cut flowers that fit into approved Burial Park vases are permitted. No artificial flowers or wreaths are permitted in these months.
- **November through February:** In addition to fresh cut flowers artificial/seasonal floral displays are permitted so long as they do not interfere with adjacent lots.
- **Removal of Flowers:** Fresh flowers (and in winter, artificial floral displays) that deteriorate, become unsightly or otherwise contravene the rules and regulations will be removed from gravesites and disposed of at the discretion of the Burial Park and without notice to the lot holder.
- **Spring Cleanup of Artificial Flowers:** All artificial flowers and wreaths are removed from gravesites starting on March 1. This is done to prepare for seasonal grounds maintenance. Spring cleanup and the disposal of items picked up is done without notice to lot holders. Families who wish to retain or recover winter displays are responsible to do so before March 1.

MEMORIALS

- Families must contact the Burial Park office or local stonemasons for detailed information relating to the criteria for permissible memorials.
- Only memorials that meet the established Rules and Regulations of the Burial Park are permitted on lots within the cemetery.
- Markers that do not meet the established Rules and Regulations will be refused delivery.
- Only Burial Park staff are permitted to install memorials at the Burial Park and all installations are performed according to established procedures.
- Unauthorized installation of a memorial or, altering or tampering with installed memorials is not permitted and such installation or amendments will be rectified by the Burial Park without notice.

ADORNMENTS / DECORATIONS / PLANTING

- Other than the placement of authorized flowers and memorials no other form of ornamentation, decoration or planting is permitted on any lot at any time.
- Items such as personal mementos, photos, decorative vases, candles, landscape rock, plants and plantings, etc. placed on or in the lot are subject to removal and disposal at the discretion of the Burial Park and without notice to the lot holder.
